Review of the year

We had a total income of £40,439, of which £37,731 was from individual donations. This included £6,400 from our very generous anonymous sponsor, £1,000 from a group volunteer, a £2,500 anonymous donation, and around £7,000 from being featured on Ebay's 'Give At Checkout' in November 2017. The remainder included £761 from Give As You Live, £1,000 in Waste Prevention Grants from Cumbria County Council, and £947 from advertising.

Our expenditure was £42,366. IT costs were £22,128 and we spent £19,072 on media, publicity, volunteer support and fundraising, £610 on the Cumbria Waste Prevention project, £392 on public liability insurance, and £164 on administration.

This resulted in a deficit for the year of £1,927, but we had a surplus brought forward from last year of £30,037 so are left with reserves of £28,110, of which £1,894 are restricted for specific costs, and £26,216 are unrestricted.

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NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 5 APRIL 2018

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

These accounts are prepared on a cash basis. This means that income and expenditure is only recorded when cash has been received or paid out.

2 Related parties

During the year, the Society purchased services valued at £20,000 from Edward Hibbert and services valued at £15,840 from Catriona Fletcher who are both directors of the Society. All of these purchases of services were at discounted rates and there were no outstanding balances at the balance sheet date.

Two directors received reimbursements for goods and services purchased for the company during the year – Edward Hibbert £1,031 and Catriona Fletcher £1,370

3 Restricted funds

At the start of the year, we had £394 remaining from the fund restricted to 'Making Freegle Sustainable'. We spent this on volunteer support, leaving a balance of zero.

In May 2016 and March 2017, Freegle received Waste Prevention Grants from Cumbria County Council totalling £1,900. A further £1,000 was received in this financial year. £1,445 was spent in previous years, and £610 in this financial year, leaving a balance of £845.

Give It For Good Ltd gave £900 to Freegle Ltd in May 2016 to cover the cost of adding the facility to list details of alternative re-use outlets to the FD system. This has not yet been spent. We continue to hold £144 belonging to Lewes Freegle and now also hold £5 for Penrith and Eden

4 Reserves

We aim to keep at least one year's basic running costs of £1,500 relating to administration and IT costs in unrestricted reserves.
