

of the
FRIMLEY GREEN WORKING MEN'S CLUB

Register No. 1334 W.

Rule 2. Line 6. (Line 8 in reprint)

Delete " 20p." and substitute " £5." 

Rule 9.

Delete whole of the first paragraph from
"The club shall" to "for re-election"
and substitute:-

"The club shall have the following officers:


three trustees, a president, vice president,
treasurer and secretary and assistant secretary.

The trustees shall be appointed only at a general
meeting by resolution of a majority of the members
present and entitled to vote thereat and shall
remain in office for a period of five years and
be eligible for re-election. The president, vice
president, treasurer, Secretary and assistant
secretary shall be elected by ballot at the
election following the Annual General Meeting
and shall remain in office for the following
periods:-

President 3 years. Vice President 2 years

Secretary 3 years. Assistant
Secretary 2 years

Treasurer 3 years. All officers as

listed shall be eligible for re-election." 

Rule 12. After end of rule. Add :-

"except in case of emergency and in the interests
of the club when such steps as are necessary may
be taken and remuneration or payment of cost may
be made at the discretion of the committee.

The committee shall have power to make payments
to a selected entertainment chair person from time
to time as decided by rule of the management
committee."


