During this year The Society for The Reduction of Carbon Limited, trading as Carbon Co-op, has promoted reductions in greenhouse gas emissions, including the promotion of clean energy sources and developing measures for retrofitting buildings to reduce energy use.					
Funding from Manchester City Council has enabled us to further develop of whole house assessment method and we have carried out more assessments.					
From the properties assessed we have chosen the first 12 candidates for whole house retrofit work and used these to start developing a Pattern Book of architectural drawings for retrofit projects.					
This building work will be completed next year and create a network of Eco Show Homes for visitors to see what is achievable.

Report of the directors for the year ended 30 September 2013

The directors present their report and the accounts for the year ended 30 September 2013.

Principal activities

The society's principal activity was to promote reduced emissions of greenhouse gases, including promoting clean energy sources and retrofitting of houses with carbon saving technology.

Statement of responsibilities of the society's management committee

1 Accounting policies

a Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

b Turnover

Turnover represents the net total of goods sold and delivered during the financial year, excluding VAT and is entirely attributable to activity within the United Kingdom.

c Cash flow statement

The co-operative has taken advantage of the exemption under Financial Reporting Standard 1 from preparing a Cash Flow Statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

d Operating leases

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
