## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2015

### 1 Accounting policies

### 1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

### 1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

### 1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts.

### 1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life. No depreciation is charged until the equipment is operational.

### 2 Taxation

No tax arises due to the loss for the period enhanced by the availability of capital allowances on plant additions. There remains tax losses of £34,890 available for relief against future years' profits.

The Co-operative made a share offer in which raised £1.477M towards the cost of acquisition and installation of solar panels on the roofs of community buildings to generate electricity for those community organisations and the national grid.
