Rescind the rule and substitute: "Before any general meeting can start its business there must be a quorum present. A quorum is either one-tenth of all shareholders with a minimum number of three and a maximum number of 25, or one-half of all shareholders with no minimum or maximum number. As part of the quorum at least two shareholders must be present in person."

Rule D.2

Rescind the rule and substitute: "The board shall consist of four board members, or such greater number not exceeding fifteen (including co-optees) as may be determined by the first board members before the first annual general meeting and thereafter by the association in general meeting. A majority of board members shall always be capable of appointment or election by the shareholders."
