Rule 22

A new rule hasbeen inserted at 22. The wording of the new rule is:

- 22. The Society may issue two classes of shares, Class A Shares and Class B Shares.
 - (a) The different classes of share may pay different interest rates, as determined by the Board, from time to time and at such rate as may be determined by the Board, but not exceeding the minimum rate necessary in the opinion of the Board to obtain and retain the capital required to carry out the objects of the Society.
 - (b) All shares irrespective of their class or issue will have the same voting rights and all shares will be treated in the same way in the case of a reduction in share value under Rule 34. It shall not be possible to convert share classes. Shares shall not beredeemable.

Rules 23 (formerly rule 22)

Rule 22 becomes rule 23. 'Class A' has been inserted before each reference to share, shares or shareholding in this rule.

Rule 24 (formerly rule 23)

Rule 23 becomes rule 24. 'Class A' has been inserted before the first appearance of the word 'shares' in line one and before the word 'shareholding' in lines 2 and 3.

The words 'the value of their shares' on line 5 shall be replaced by 'The nominal value of their Class A shares'.

Rule 25 (formerly rule 24)

Rule 24 becomes rule 25. 'Class A' has been inserted before the word share or shares on lines 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Rule 26 (formerly rule 25)

Rule 25 becomes rule 26. The words 'is unable to transfer their shares' have been deleted from lines 1 and 2. 'Class A' has been inserted before the word share or shares on lines 2 and 3.

Rule 27 (formerly rule 26)

Rule 26 becomes rule 27. 'Class A' has been inserted before the word shares on line 1.

Rule 28

A new rule has been inserted at 28. The wording of the new rule is:

28. 'Class B' shares shall be of the nominal value of £1.00. The minimum Class B shareholding required of a Member shall be defined as such number of fully paid Class B shares as the Committee may determine subject to the Act, or as may be required by a particular offer of Class B shares, or, failing such determination or requirement, shall be one Class B share and shall be transferable and not withdrawable.

Rule 29 (formerly rule 27)

Rule 27 becomes rule 29. 'Class A' has been inserted before each reference to share, shares or shareholding in this rule.

Rule 30 (formerly rule 28)

Rule 28 becomes rule 30. 'Class A' has been inserted before the word share.

Rule 31 (formerly rule 29)

Rule 29 becomes rule 31. 'Class A' has been inserted before each reference to shares in this rule.

Rule 32 (formerly rule 30)

Rule 30 becomes rule 32. 'Class A' has been inserted before the word shares on line 2 of this rule.

Rule 33

A new rule has been inserted at 33. The wording of the new rule is:

Class B shares shall be transferable only with the prior written consent of the Board of Directors. Subject to the restrictions imposed by this rule, any member may transfer all or any of his shares by written instrument in any form approved by the Board executed by and on behalf of the transferor and transferee but the transfer shall not be effective until the transferee is entered in the register of members as the holder of the shares transferred. The Board may at its absolute discretion decline to register a transfer of shares to a person who is not already a member but if the Board registers the transfer then that person shall be entered into the register of member.

33. Subsequent rules

The number of all subsequent rules has increased in value by 3. There are no other changes to rules 34 to 125 (formerly 31 to 122)
